DAVROS HEAD

This is truly a wonderful prop for those who collect items from the beloved English TV science fiction show that sent kids running behind the sofa. This full size Davros head was taken from the original BBC mould used for "Reserrection of the Daleks", "Revelation of the Daleks" and "Rememberance of the Daleks", now believed destroyed. It is thought of to be the only one of its type. The original Davros rubber mask is now in a very poor repair state and still thought to be owned by the BBC. This is made from fibreglass and captures every nuance of the original sculpture, but because it is made in fibreglass, will not decay. It has been expertly painted by one of the master craftsmen who worked on the show in the original paint scheme. Please note that there are replicas of the mask out there made by imagineering in the 1980's but these are of poor quality when compared to this...truly the ultimate villain head!

This head in the visage of the evil Davros, creator of the Daleks, is a chilling reminder of one of the most dangerous enemies of the good Doctor.

Comes with a letter of authenticity concerning the provenence and is from the private collection of one of the worlds foremost experts on the show, who has worked on "Doctor Who" and catalogued the BBC Doctor Who auction in the 1990's for Bonhams of London.


